
## Woodland Animals Table Runner



Sample made with Marcus Fabrics Primo Plaids Lumber Jacks and the
Woodland Getaway fabric Panel by Cindy Staub
Finished size 10 ½" x 26 ½"

- R19 Woodland Getaway Panel 0815-0146
- Border- 34- 2 ½' Squares from Primo Plaid Lumber Jacks from several plaids for a scappy look.
- Binding- ¼ yard
- Backing- 1/3 yard
- Batting- 11" x 28" rectangle

## Let's begin!

From Woodland Getaway Panel Fabric fussy cut;

- 1- Bear block, 6 ½" x 12 ½"
- 1- Moose block, 6 ½" x 12 ½" (or animals of your choice)
- ❖ ¼" seam thru out.
- Embroider the animal panels if desired.

Panel can be left plain.

- ❖ Sew the "Bear" block and "Moose" blocks together right sides together side by side to form a 6 ½" x 24 ½" rectangle
- Sew 12 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares together to form a 12 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- ❖ Sew 5 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares together to form a 5 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- Sew the 12 square pieced border strips to the top and bottom of the center rectangle, right sides together. Iron. Sew the 5 square pieced border strips to each side, right sides together. Iron.
- ❖ Layer backing, batting and table runner top together and quilt as desired.

**Binding using Primo Plaid flannel**: Cut  $2-1\,\%$ " strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Sew onto mug rug front with a %" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and fold over %" and hem the binding to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.

❖ Binding if using cotton weight fabric: Cut 2- 2 ½" strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together, iron. Sew onto the mug rug front with a ¾" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and stitch to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.





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## Sleep Under the Stars and Snuggle Up and Stay Warm Cornerstone Mug Rugs

Sample made with RO9 Primo Plaids Lumber Jacks Finished size 12 ½" x 15 ½"

- R19 Woodland Getaway Panel 0815-0146
- Border- 1/8 yard
- Cornerstones- 1/8 yard
- Binding- 1/8 yard
- Backing- 1 fat quarter or 13" x 16" rectangle
- Batting- 13" x 16" rectangle



## Let's begin!

From Woodland Getaway Fabric fussy cut;

1- tent or camper design to measure 8 ½" x 11 ½"

From Border Fabric Cut;

2 – 2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles

2 – 2 ½" x 11 ½" rectangles

From Cornerstone fabric cut;

4 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

- ❖ ¼" seam thru out.
- Embroider the fussy cut tent or camper design if desired. Panel can be left plain.
- Sew 2 ½"x 8 ½" border rectangle to each side of the Snowman Mug Rug rectangle.
- Sew 2 ½" x 2 ½" cornerstone square to each end of the 2 ½" x 11 ½" border rectangle. Iron.
- Sew the pieced border strip to the top and bottom of the mug rug, right sides together. Lining up the seams. Iron.
- ❖ Layer backing, batting and mug rug top together and quilt as desired.

**Binding using Primo Plaid flannel**: Cut  $2 - 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Sew onto mug rug front with a 1/4" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and fold over 1/4" and hem the binding to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.

❖ Binding if using cotton weight fabric: Cut 2- 2 ½" strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together, iron. Sew onto the mug rug front with a 1/2" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and stitch to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.









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
