Hen and Chicks Table Runner



Sample made with Marcus Fabrics Aunt Grace's Apron by Judie Rothermel and the Blue Ribbon fabric Panel by Cindy Staub Finished size 10 ½" x 26 ½"

- R19 Blue Ribbon Panel 0791-0146
- Border- 34- 2 ½' Squares from Aunt Grace's Apron Fabric, use up to 16 different fabrics for a scappy look.
- Binding- ¼ yard
- Backing- 1/3 yard
- Batting- 11" x 28" rectangle

Let's begin!

From Blue Ribbon Panel Fabric fussy cut;

- 1- Hen on Nest block, 6 ½" x 12 ½"
- 1- Little Chicks block, 6 ½" x 12 ½"
- ✤ ¼" seam thru out.
- Embroider the mug rug panel if desired.
 Panel can be left plain.
- Sew the "Hen on Nest" block and "Little Chicks" block together right sides together side by side to form a 6 ½" x 24 ½" rectangle
- Sew 12 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares together to form a 12 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- Sew 5 − 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares together to form a 5 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- Sew the 12 square pieced border strips to the top and bottom of the center rectangle, right sides together. Iron.
 Sew the 5 square pieced border strips to each side, right sides together. Iron.
- Layer backing, batting and table runner top together and quilt as desired.
- Binding: Cut 3- 2 ½" strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together, iron. Sew onto the mug rug front with a ¼" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and stitch to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.

Grandma's Hollyhock Table Runner

- R19 Blue Ribbon Panel 0791-0146
- Border- 34- 2 ½' Squares from Aunt Grace's Apron Fabric, use up to 16 different fabrics for a scappier look.
- Binding- ¼ yard
- Backing- 1/3 yard
- Batting- 11" x 28" rectangle

Let's begin!

From Blue Ribbon Panel Fabric fussy cut; 1- Hollyhock Flower block, 6 ½" x 24 ½"



- ✤ ¼" seam thru out.
- Embroider the mug rug panel if desired.
 Panel can be left plain.
- Sew 12 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares together to form a 12 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- Sew 5 − 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares together to form a 5 square strip. Iron. Make two.
- Sew the 12 square pieced border strips to each of the long sides of the center rectangle, right sides together.
 Iron. Sew the 5 square pieced border strips top and bottom of the table runner, right sides together.
- Layer backing, batting and table runner top together and quilt as desired.
- Binding: Cut 3- 2 ½" strips x WOF. Sew end to end. Fold in half lengthwise wrong sides together, iron. Sew onto the mug rug front with a ¼" seam, miter the corners. Fold binding around the outer edge of the mug rug and stitch to the back of the quilt using a blind stitch with matching thread.
